Stone Marine Shipcare Launch New Mobile Workshop

Stone Marine Shipcare Ltd (SMS) has recently developed a mobile workshop for rapid response to propeller repairs worldwide. This fully equipped workshop can be deployed at short notice anywhere in Europe by road transport and worldwide by shipping.

The mobile workshop allows our service team to be totally self-sufficient when attending shipyards that rarely have the necessary equipment required to carry out large propeller repairs. All equipment including welding machines, post-weld heat treatment, balancing, measuring and 3D scanning are located inside.

Our mobile workshop has recently headed out to meet up with our service team in Oman Dry Dock, Duqm.

Our 4 man service team is to carry out a large propeller repair putting their many years of propeller repair experience into action.

The team had previously attended this vessel, cropping all 4 propeller blade tips, removing severe bend damage and restoring propeller balance which allowed the vessel to remain afloat and resume normal service within 24 hours.

During the cropping operation, the necessary measurements were taken in order to manufacture new replacement tip sections. The 4 new tip pieces (2 of which weigh in excess of 500Kgs) are now on route to Oman safely located inside the mobile workshop where they will be welded into place following our Class approved repair procedures.

The vessel's dry docking schedule is 14 days and we expect all propeller repair work to be completed within 10 days, allowing the vessel to continue without delay.
